Determination:

It was common case that the appellant's employment ended due to redundancy following a period of lay off. The Tribunal awards the appellant a redundancy lump sum under the Redundancy Payments Acts, 1967 to 2007 based on the following information:

Date of Termination:	01 March 2011
Gross Pay:	€ 253.84
Amount of redundancy payment:	€4371.12

The appellant's service from 22 July 2010 to 01 March 2011 is non-reckonable for redundancy purposes.

This award is made subject to the appellant having been in insurable employment under the Social Welfare Acts during the relevant period.
