She received notice of termination of her employment on the 8<sup>th</sup> March 2006 and continued working until the 10<sup>th</sup> March. She was not paid for these two days.

Having satisfied itself that the respondent was properly on notice of the hearing date and having heard the evidence, the Tribunal award the claimant the sum of €312.00, being one week's pay, under the Minimum Notice and Terms of Employment Acts, 1973 to 2001.
