Determination:

Based on the uncontroverted evidence of the appellant, showing that one week's pay in lieu of notice had been received, loss having been established, the Tribunal finds that the appellant is entitled to payments under the Redundancy Payments Acts, 1967 to 2003 and the Minimum Notice and Terms of Employment Acts, 1973 to 2001 based on the following criteria.
