The determination of the Tribunal was as follows:

Determination:

Having considered the evidence in this case the Tribunal is satisfied that the appellant was dismissed by reason of redundancy and is entitled to a lump sum payment under the Redundancy Payments Acts, 1967 to 2003. The Tribunal is further satisfied that the respondent was the subject of a transfer of undertaking in May 2003 and that the appellant's service should include that prior to this transfer. The Tribunal was further satisfied that a second transfer of undertaking took place in September 2006 and, as the evidence showed that he had been made aware of this case, the thirdnamed respondent was added to the proceedings. The appellant's lump sum is based on the following criteria: -
