Determination:

Based on the uncontroverted evidence of the appellant, the Tribunal finds that the appellant is entitled to a lump sum payment under the Redundancy Payments Acts, 1967 to 2003 based on the following criteria.

18/04/1966	01/10/1999	02/12/2005	€750-00

The evidence having shown that there was no loss the claim under the Minimum Notice and Terms of Employment Acts, 1973 to 2001 must fail.

It should be noted that payments from the Social Insurance fund are limited to €600-00 per week.
