The decision of the Tribunal was as follows:

The redundancy and minimum notice claims were not in dispute. The Tribunal was satisfied that the delay in lodging this claim was due to the claimant's lack of English. Therefore the time within which to lodge the claim is extended.

Determination

The Tribunal awards the appellant his statutory redundancy lump sum payment under the Redundancy Payments Acts, 1967 to 2001 based the following information:

Date of Birth:	6 th January 1951
Date of Commencement:	10 th October 2001
Date of Termination:	19 th June 2004.
Gross weekly pay:	€300

The Tribunal awards the claimant the amount of €600 (being two weeks pay) under the Minimum Notice and Terms of Employment Acts 1973 to 2001.

The claim under the Organisation of Working Time Act, 1997 was dismissed.
