The determination of the Tribunal was as follows:

Determination:

The employer conceded that the dismissal was unfair in this case. The Tribunal heard evidence from the Claimant as to his loss and he was cross-examined on this evidence. The Tribunal have also examined the Claimant's pay slips and determines his average weekly pay to be €469.00.

Accordingly, under the Unfair Dismissals Acts, 1977 to 2001, the Tribunal awards the Claimant compensation in the sum of €12,200.00, as is just and equitable having regard to all the circumstances

Under the Minimum Notice and Terms Of Employment Acts, 1973 to 2001, the Tribunal awards the Claimant the sum of €938.00, being two weeks gross pay as compensation.

The claim under the Organisation Of Working Time Act, 1997, was withdrawn.
