The decision of the Tribunal was as follows:

Determination:

Having heard all the evidence the Tribunal is not satisfied that there was continuity of service. The Tribunal have great sympathy for the plight in which the Appellant found herself. It was not unreasonable for the employer to have assumed that the Appellant left her employment voluntarily.

The appeal in that her previous employment was to be included in her redundancy calculation, under the Redundancy Payments, Acts, 1977 to 2001, must fail.
