The Tribunal were satisfied that the respondent had been properly served notice of the hearing date for the above case.

Appellant's Case:

The appellant was placed on temporary lay-off on the 3 March 2006. When he had not heard from the respondent for approximately eight weeks he contacted the company about the availability of work and received a letter informing him that the respondent would contact him as soon as suitable work became available. By September 2006 he had not received work nor had he been contacted. He organised a meeting with the respondent. The appellant requested his P-45. The appellant heard nothing further from the respondent and his telephone calls to them remained unanswered. The appellant commenced new employment in around September 2006.

Determination:

The Tribunal awards the appellant €1,390.00 (being the equivalent of two weeks' wages) as his statutory entitlement under the Minimum Notice & Terms of Employment Acts, 1973 to 2001.
