Complainant's Case

The declaration of the Tribunal was as follows:-

The complainant's employment commenced on 17 April 2006 and ended on 8 May 2006. When the employment ended he was owed wages for the last 1.2 weeks that he had worked. He was also owed one day's pay for outstanding holidays due to him when his employment ceased. His gross weekly pay from the company had been €470.00.

Minister's Case

The Tribunal was told that it was not possible to dispute the claims because it had not been possible

to obtain records from the company which was now insolvent. Correspondence sent to a director of the company had not been answered.

Declaration:

Under the Protection of Employees (Employers' Insolvency) Acts, 1984 to 2001, the Tribunal declares that the complainant is entitled to the sum of €564.00 (this amount being equivalent to 1.2 weeks' gross pay at €470.00 per week) for arrears of wages and, in addition, to the sum of €94.00 (this amount being equivalent to 0.2 weeks' gross pay at €470.00 per week) for his outstanding holiday entitlement at the end of his employment.
