**Determination:**

There was no appearance or representation by the Respondent. Based on the uncontested evidence the Tribunal awards the Appellant his statutory lump sum payment under the Redundancy Payments, Acts, 1977 to 2001, based on his continuous service and the following information:

Date of Birth: 28<sup>th</sup> March 1961

Date of Commencement: 01<sup>st</sup> May 1996

Date of Termination: 25<sup>th</sup> May 2006

Gross Weekly Wage: €769.00

It should be noted that a statutory weekly ceiling of €600.00 applies to payments from the Social Insurance Fund.

Under the Organisation Of Working Time Act, 1997, the Tribunal awards the Appellant €1,538.00, this being two weeks holiday pay.
