Appellant's case:

The appellant worked as chef for the respondent from 2nd April 2003 to 23rd December 2006 when the business closed down. The respondent promised him another job but that did not materialise.

Determination:

The Tribunal is satisfied that the appellant's employment ended by reason of redundancy and he is entitled to a redundancy lump sum under the Redundancy Payments Acts 1967 to 2003 based on the following:
