The decision of the Tribunal was as follows:

Determination:

The representative for the Respondent, in correspondence to the Tribunal, indicated "out of courtesy", that he would not be attending the hearing and that the Respondent had ceased trading. The Appellant was paid a Redundancy Payment Lump Sum of €5,776.00, however having heard the uncontested evidence the Tribunal determines that the Appellant's service was greater than this amount reflected.

Accordingly, the tribunal determines that the appellant is entitled to a redundancy lump sum payment under the Redundancy Payments Acts, 1967 to 2003 based on her continuous service and the following information and subtracting €5,776.00 from the total:

Date of Birth: 19th November 1952
Date of Commencement: 14th August 1983

Date of Termination: 07th September 2005
Gross weekly pay: €375.00
Less the amount of €5,776.00, paid from the Social Insurance Fund.
