## **Determination:**

Date of termination of employment:	30 <sup>th</sup> June 2006
Gross weekly pay:	€400.00.

The representative for the respondent and the appellant agreed that two weeks' notice had been paid. Accordingly, the Tribunal awards the appellant the amount of  $\notin$ 800.00 (being the two weeks' pay outstanding) under the Minimum Notice and Terms of Employment Acts, 1973 to 2001.
