The determination of the Tribunal was as follows:

The claimant in this case received a letter dated 2 February 2007 from the company. The wording of that letter gave the claimant the clear impression his employment was being terminated. The Tribunal believes that this is the only reasonable interruption. However, the Tribunal also believes that thereafter, the respondent made genuine efforts to encourage the claimant back into full employment. Notwithstanding, the Tribunal believes that the letter dated 2 February 2007 constituted a dismissal, which, in the circumstances was unfair. Accordingly, the Tribunal awardsthe claimant €590.00 under the Unfair Dismissals Acts, 1977 to 2001.

The claim under the Organisation of Working Time Act, 1997 fails.
