The decision of the Tribunal was as follows:-

Respondent's Case:

The representative for the respondent stated that all monies in respect of redundancy payments and minimum notice had been paid to all employees. In the appellants' cases they stated that he had been paid redundancy and minimum notice during the period from May 5th 1998 to October 6th 2006.

First-Named Appellant's Case:

The first-named appellant stated that he had commenced employment with the first in a line of four security companies on March 1st 1995. The contract was taken over by a second security company on May 5th 1998. He stated that a transfer of undertakings took place and produced a letter from the second security company confirming the transfer of undertakings.

Second-Named Appellant's Case:

The second-named appellant stated that he had commenced employment with the first in a line of four security companies on June 1st 1995. The contract was taken over by a second security company on May 5th 1998. He stated that a transfer of undertakings took place and produced a letter from the second security company confirming the transfer of undertakings.

Determination:

First-named Appellant

The Tribunal is satisfied that a transfer of undertakings took place between 1995 and 1998 and therefore the appellant is entitled to a lump sum payment under the Redundancy Payments Acts, 1967 to 2003, based on the following criteria:

Date of Birth:	February 11 th 1964
Date of Commencement:	March 1 st 1995
Date of Termination:	May 4 th 1998
Gross Weekly Pay:	€ 561.36

The Tribunal awards the appellant €1,122.72 (being the equivalent of two weeks' wages) as his statutory entitlement under the Minimum Notice & Terms of Employment Acts, 1973 to 2001.

Second-named Appellant

The Tribunal is satisfied that a transfer of undertakings took place between 1995 and 1998 and therefore the appellant is entitled to a lump sum payment under the Redundancy Payments Acts, 1967 to 2003, based on the following criteria:

Date of Birth:	December 23 rd 1974
Date of Commencement:	June 1 st 1995
Date of Termination:	May 4 th 1998
Gross Weekly Pay:	€ 561.09

The Tribunal awards the appellant €1,122.18 (being the equivalent of two weeks' wages) as his statutory entitlement under the Minimum Notice & Terms of Employment Acts, 1973 to 2001.
