Based on the evidence adduced the Tribunal determines that the Appellant is entitled to his statutory redundancy lump sum payment under the Redundancy Payments Acts, 1967 to 2003, based on the following information:

Date of Birth: 7^{th} February 1985Date of Commencement: 10^{th} December 2003Date of Termination: 2^{nd} March 2007Gross Weekly Wage:€600.00

It was unclear which of the above named was the employer, as the tax documents submitted refer to both. The Tribunal therefore makes this award against both severally and jointly.

The Tribunal also awards the Appellant €1,200.00 compensation (being the equivalent of 2 weeks pay) under the Minimum Notice and Terms Of Employment Acts, 1973 to 2001.
