The Tribunal believes that the claimant, because he worked for the respondent for more than six months, is entitled to one week's notice of the termination of his employment. Such notice was not given to him. Accordingly, the Tribunal awards the claimant the sum of €766.80 under the Minimum Notice and Terms of Employment Acts, 1973 to 2001.

The appeal under the Organisation of Working Time Act, 1997 was withdrawn at the outset of this hearing.
