The determination of the Tribunal was as follows:

Having heard the submissions and comments from the parties the Tribunal is satisfied that the appellant was dismissed by reason of redundancy. Accordingly his appeal under the Redundancy Payments Acts, 1967 to 2001 is allowed and the appellant is awarded a statutory amount based on the following:

Date of Birth: 04 February 1975 Date of Commencement: 28 February 1996 Date of Termination: 24 February 2006

Gross Weekly Wage: €710.00

Since those Acts are mutually exclusive with the Unfair Dismissals Acts, 1977 to 2001 it follows that his claim under the latter Acts fall.

The Tribunal awards the appellant €2840.00 as compensation for four weeks' notice under the Minimum notice and Terms of Employment Acts, 1973 to 2001

The appeal under the Organisation of Working Time Act, 1997 succeeds and the appellant is awarded €3124.00 for outstanding holiday pay.
