The decision of the Tribunal was as follows:-
The appellant has brought a claim for implementation of the Rights Commissioners Recommendation (Ref: r-045090-te-06).
The Tribunal is satisfied that the time delimited by section 8(2)(a) of the Terms of Employment (Information) Act, 1994, to appeal a Recommendation of the Rights Commissioners, has expired without an appeal having been brought to the Tribunal, and this was confirmed by both parties in attendance at the Tribunal hearing on the above date.
As the time for appeal has expired, the only evidence that the Tribunal can hear is in relation to the performance, or otherwise, of the Recommendation. The Tribunal cannot at this stage reopen the merits of the case heard before the Rights Commissioner.
The Tribunal is satisfied that the Recommendation has not been given effect to and, therefore, under Section 8(6)(a), implements the Rights Commissioners' Recommendation and makes determination to the like effect, awarding the appellant the amount of €1,000.00 under the Terms of Employment (Information) Act, 1994.
