The Tribunal is satisfied that the respondent was properly notified of this hearing. Neither the respondent nor a representative on her behalf appeared for the hearing.

Based on the uncontested evidence of the appellant the Tribunal finds that her employment with the respondent was terminated by reason of redundancy and without sufficient and proper notice. She is therefore awarded a statutory amount under the Redundancy Payments Acts, 1967 to 2003 and based on the following:
