The appellant appeared at the hearing and told the Tribunal that he was a van driver for the respondent company. He attended work to fill his van and could not find the key. The premises were locked and he could not get access. Another employee informed him that his job was finished.

Determination:

The Tribunal awards the appellant €1670.96 (being four weeks' wages) under the Minimum Notice and Terms of Employment Acts, 1973 to 2001, and is satisfied that the appellant's position became redundant. He is entitled to his statutory lump sum payment under the Redundancy Payments Acts, 1967 to 2003, based on the following criteria:
