The decision of the Tribunal was as follows:-

The appellant's employment ended by reason of redundancy. He worked for the respondent from 7th May 1997 to 12th December 2006 without a break in his service. He confirmed his date of birth as 18th July 1961 and his weekly wage as being €421.

Determination:

The Tribunal is satisfied that the appellant's employment ended by reason of redundancy and he is entitled to a redundancy lump sum under the Redundancy Payments Acts 1967 to 2003 based on the following:
