This matter came before the Tribunal by way of an employee appealing against the recommendation of a Rights Commissioner in the case of Employee –vs- Employer (ref no. r-037862-pw-05-DI) under the Payment of Wages Act, 1991. At the outset, the representative forthe appellant confirmed that a Transfer of Undertakings had taken place and the correct respondentwas named above.
