The decision of the Tribunal was as follows:-

The appellant was employed by the respondent as a Chef from 15<sup>th</sup> September 2001 to 24<sup>th</sup> December 2006. The respondent's business ceased trading on 24<sup>th</sup> December 2006 and the appellant's employment ended. The respondent intimated to the appellant that he might be able to re-employ him as a Chef in another restaurant butnothing came of this.

The Tribunal, having heard such evidence as was produced, is satisfied that the appellant is entitled to a redundancy payment. The Tribunal awards the appellant a redundancy lump sum under the Redundancy Payments Acts, 1967 to 2003 based on the following criteria:

Date of birth:26th October 1967Date of commencement: $15^{th}$  September 2001Date of termination: $24^{th}$  December 2006Gross weekly Pay:€616.70

It should be noted that a statutory weekly ceiling of  $\in 600.00$  applies to payments from the Social Insurance Fund.
