The decision of the Tribunal was as follows:-

Appellant's Case

The appellant sought a redundancy lump sum payment based on his commencement date of 24 May 1989, his termination date of 31 August 2005, his gross weekly pay of €1,035.00 per week and his date of birth which was 22 June 1966.

Respondent's Case

The respondent's representative did not contest the appellant's evidence.

Determination:

On the uncontested evidence of the appellant, the Tribunal allows the appeal under the Redundancy Payments Acts, 1967 to 2003, and finds that the appellant is entitled to a redundancy lump sumbased on his commencement date of 24 May 1989, his termination date of 31 August 2005, his gross weekly pay of €1,035.00 per week and his date of birth which was 22 June 1966.

Note: in the case of social insurance fund payments, a statutory ceiling of €600.00 gross per week is applicable.
