The determination of the Tribunal was as follows: -

## Determination

The respondent conceded that dismissal was unfair.

The claimant's loss of earnings amount to  $\in 8,950$  and he has an ongoing loss of  $\in 250$  per week into the future. The Tribunal are requested to assess compensation as is just and equitable in all the circumstances.

The Tribunal had regard to the following:

- (1) the claimant's diligence in seeking work outside even his trade at a lower rate of pay
- (2) Changes in the economic state of the printing industry, in which both sides seemed to be agreed
- (3) the financial state of the respondent
- (4) the respondent's acknowledgment of their default when the hearing began
- (5) agreement on both sides that reinstatement was not appropriate

The Tribunal assess a figure of €15,000.
