The decision of the Tribunal was as follows:-

Based on the uncontested evidence of the Appellant, the Tribunal is satisfied that she is entitled to a lump sum payment under the Redundancy Payments Acts, 1967 to 2003 based on the following criteria: -

Date of Birth	Employment Commenced	Employment Ended	Gross Weekly Pay
7 August 1982	2 February 2005	25 August 2007	€360.00

The Tribunal awards the appellant €720.00 (being two weeks' wages) under the Minimum Notice and Terms of Employment Acts, 1973 to 2001.

Under the Organisation of Working Time Act, 1997, the Tribunal awards the appellant €720.00 being the equivalent of 8 days' pay.
