Having considered the submissions from both parties the Tribunal finds that the appellant was dismissed by reason of redundancy. He is therefore awarded a redundancy sum under the Redundancy Payments Acts, 1967 to 2003 and based on the following:

Gross Weekly Wage: €375.00

The appeal under the Minimum Notice and Terms of employment Acts, 1973 to 2001 is also allowed and the appellant is awarded €450.00 as compensation for his outstanding notice entitlement.
