Determination

The claim under the Minimum Notice and Terms of Employment Acts, 1973 to 2001 fails as the claimant was not dismissed.

Under the Organisation of Working Time Act, 1997 the Tribunal awards the claimant the sum of €944.23, being the equivalent of fourteen days' pay.
