## **Determination:**

This case came before the Tribunal by way of an appeal by the employer against the decision of a Rights Commissioner, PW42798/06/MR dated 13 November 2006.

The Tribunal is satisfied that the Respondent was notified in advance of the hearing. However, neither he, nor a representative on his behalf, appeared.

Based on the uncontested evidence of the Appellant, the Tribunal upsets the decision of the Rights Commissioner, and, accordingly finds that the employee is not entitled to the sum of €1,643.96 awarded in the Rights Commissioner's decision.
