Determination:

Based on the uncontested evidence of the claimant the Tribunal finds that a redundancy situation existed.

The Tribunal awards the claimant €1,200.00, being two weeks wages, under the Minimum Notice and Terms of Employment Acts, 1973 to 2001.

The Tribunal awards the claimant €1,800.00 under the Organisation of Working Time Act, 1997.

The Tribunal finds that the claimant is entitled to a payment under the Redundancy Payments Acts, 1967 to 2003 based on the following information:
