The Tribunal is satisfied that the respondent was properly notified of this hearing. Neither the respondent nor a representative on its behalf appeared for this hearing.

Based on the uncontested evidence of the claimants the Tribunal allows both appeals. Accordingly, Marek Tabor is awarded €300.00 for one week's notice entitlement under the Minimum Notice and Terms of Employment Acts, 1973 to 2001. He is also awarded €1200.00 for outstanding holiday entitlements under the Organisation of Working Time Act, 1997.

Robert Adamezyk is awarded €300.00 under the Minimum Notice and Terms of Employment Acts, 1973 to 2001 for one week's notice. In addition he is also awarded a further €700.00 for holiday entitlements under the Organisation of Working Time Act, 1997
