The decision of the Tribunal was as follows:-

Having heard the uncontested evidence of the claimant the tribunal determines that the claimant is entitled to a redundancy lump sum payment under the Redundancy Payments Acts, 1967 to 2003, based on his continuous service and the following information:

Date of Birth:	24 th December 1950
Date of commencement of employment:	12 th May 2005
Date of termination of employment:	23 rd November 2007
Gross Weekly salary:	€330.00

The Tribunal awards the claimant the sum of €660.00 (being the equivalent of 2 weeks wages) under the Minimum Notice and Terms of Employment Acts, 1973 to 2001.

The Tribunal also awards the claimant a further sum of €660.00 being two week's wages owing under the Organisation of Working Time Act, 1997.
