The decision of the Tribunal was as follows:-

Having received a claim under the Minimum Notice and Terms of Employment Acts, 1973 to 2001, from the claimant and a notice of appearance from the respondent, the Tribunal scheduled a hearing for Wednesday 5 March 2008. Hearing notices giving the date, time and venue for the hearing were sent by registered post to both the claimant and the respondent.
