The decision of the Tribunal was as follows:

The claimant told the Tribunal that on 5th February 2007 the company manager came and told the staff that the company was entering a voluntary arrangement and they were closing the office in Ireland. The staff were told that they were to leave that day. The manager had said that their money would be paid, but the claimant had not received any payment to date. RP50 forms had been sent to the company and signed, but still no payment had been received. Accordingly, the Tribunal finds that the claimant is entitled to a redundancy payment under the Redundancy Payments Acts, 1967 to 2003 based on the following criteria.

Date of Commencement: 12th July 2004
Date of Termination: 5th February 2007
Gross Pay: €229.50
