The Tribunal is satisfied that the respondent was properly notified of this hearing. Neither the respondent nor a representative on its behalf appeared for this hearing.

During the course of her uncontested evidence the appellant acknowledged she received one week's verbal notice of the termination of her employment. However, based on her service with the respondent the appellant was entitled to four weeks' notice. Accordingly, the Tribunal awards her €1237.50 as compensation for outstanding notice under the Minimum Notice and Terms of Employment Acts, 1973 to 2001.
