The decision of the Tribunal was as follows:

Giving evidence the appellant stated that he commenced employment with the respondent in June 2000. The appellant was told he would be working on a week-to-week basis after December 2006. During January 2007 the respondent only once attended at the premises. The appellant opened the premises each day but there was no work for him to do. When he spoke to the respondent again he was told there was no money to pay him anymore. The appellant's employment was terminated in January 2007 when the respondent company effectively closed down. The Tribunal required documentary verification of the appellant's earnings for clarification purposes and the matter was adjourned to the 8th of May 2008 to facilitate this request.

The Tribunal learned of the untimely death of the applicant, which occurred subsequent to the original hearing on 24 January 2008, and as a consequence his mother represented him on 8 May 2008. She confirmed the applicant's gross weekly wage to the satisfaction of the Tribunal.

Determination:
