The decision of the Tribunal was as follows:-

The Tribunal is satisfied that the respondent was duly notified of the hearing

Appellant's case:

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The respondent was a sub-contractor. On 10th May 2007 the respondent was told there was no more work for him and that he was letting him go. This was the last day he worked for the respondent.

Determination:

The Tribunal is satisfied that the appellant's employment ended by reason of redundancy and without notice. The appellant is entitled to a redundancy lump sum payment under the Redundancy Payments Acts, 1967 to 2003 based on the following:

Date of Birth Date employment commenced Date employment ended Basic weekly wage 11th May 1966 28th January 2002 10th May 2007 €650

He is also entitled to payment of €2,600 which is the equivalent of four weeks pay in lieu of notice under the Minimum Notice and Terms of Employment Acts, 1973 to 2001.

Please note that a weekly ceiling of €600 applies to all payments from the Social Insurance Fund.
