The determination of the Tribunal was as follows:

Determination:

The respondent having conceded the claim, the Tribunal finds that the appellant is entitled to a lump sum payment under the Redundancy Payments Acts, 1967 to 2003 based on the following criteria

Date of Birth	24 August 1954
Employment commenced	1 February 1991
Employment ended	13 July 2007
Gross weekly pay	€849-97

It should be noted that payments from the social insurance fund are limited to a maximum of €600-00 per week.

Loss having been established the Tribunal awards €6,799-76, being eight weeks' pay under the Minimum Notice and Terms of Employment Acts, 1973 to 2001
