The decision of the Tribunal was as follows:-

This case was heard in conjunction with cases, RP540/07 MN339/08, RP568/07 MN794/07, and RP584/07 MN806/07.

The Tribunal is satisfied that the respondent and the liquidator were properly on notice of this hearing. The Secretary made telephone contact with the liquidator and the liquidator kindly consented by facsimile letter furnished to the Tribunal that day to the appellant amending the Form T1A by the addition of a claim under the Minimum Notice and Terms of Employment Acts, 1973 to 2001.

The appellant consented to withdraw the claim against a named director of the respondent.

The Tribunal awards the appellant €2612.52 being the equivalent of four weeks pay under the Minimum Notice and Terms of Employment Acts, 1973 to 2001.

Based on the appellant's uncontroverted evidence, the Tribunal finds that the appellant is entitled to
