The decision of the Tribunal was as follows:-

Appellants Case

The appellant gave evidence that she worked for the respondent from the 18th March 1999 until the 8th August 2007 when she was made redundant. She received €143.50 per week. The appellant handed in evidence to the Tribunal that her employer was dissolved as a limited company on the 13 th May 2005 but she continued to work for the respondent until she was made redundant.

Respondents Case

The respondent conceded that the appellant was made redundant and agreed with the position concerning the dissolution of the company as outlined above. The business continued to trade under his own name after the dissolution of the company. The business closed down when the landlord

increased the rent on the premises. He was not working at present and was not in a financial position to pay redundancy to the appellant.

Determination

The Tribunal is satisfied that the appellant was dismissed by reason of redundancy. Accordingly, the Tribunal determines that the appellant is entitled to a redundancy lump sum under the Redundancy Payments Acts, 1967 to 2003 based on her continuous service and the following information:
