## **Determination:**

The Tribunal is satisfied that the respondent was properly on notice of the hearing. The Tribunal finds, based on the uncontroverted evidence of the appellant, that the appellant is entitled to a lump sum payment under the Redundancy Payments Acts, 1967 to 2003, in accordance with the following criteria:

Date of Birth: 13<sup>th</sup> October 1960 Employment Commenced: 29<sup>th</sup>November 2004 Date of Cessation: 10<sup>th</sup> September 2007 Date of Termination: 24<sup>th</sup> September 2007

Gross Weekly Pay: €1,566.00

The Tribunal is finds that the second named respondent is the business name under which the first named respondent traded and the Tribunal dismisses the claim against the second named respondent and makes the award against the first named respondent.

A statutory gross weekly ceiling of €600.00 applies to payments from the Social Insurance Fund.

This award is made subject to the appellant fulfilling the relevant social welfare requirements in relation to PRSI contributions.
