## **Determination:**

The parties had previously settled this claim on the amount of  $\in$  11,000 on March 11<sup>th</sup> 2008. On April 1<sup>st</sup> 2008 the company went into liquidation but by that stage the agreed sum had not been paid. The liquidator confirmed that he queried the directors of the company and reaffirmed that they believed the sum of  $\in$  11,000 "was a fair and reasonable settlement". He added that he saw "no basis for me to second guess the commercial decision made by the directors".

The Tribunal heard evidence from the claimant and made it's determination under the Unfair Dismissals Acts, 1977 to 2001. In the Tribunal's view it is "just and equitable having regard to allthe circumstances" (Section 7 (1)(c)) to award the claimant compensation in the sum
