The decision of the Tribunal was as follows:-

## **Appellants' case:**

The second named appellant told the Tribunal that the managing director of the respondent became unwell and when the employees including herself turned up for work on 13<sup>th</sup> July 2007 the doors were locked. The office has not been opened since. The first named appellant was on two weeks holidays and when she returned she found that all the staff had left while she was on holidays and the newspaper had not been published the previous week.

## **Determination:**

The Tribunal is satisfied that the appellants' employment ended by reason of redundancy and they are due a redundancy lump sum under the Redundancy Payments Acts, 1967 to 2003 based on the following:
