On the uncontested evidence of the appellant she is entitled to a lump sum payment under the Redundancy Payments Acts, 1967 to 2003 based on the following criteria:-

Date of birth	06 July 1963
Date employment began	28 March 1995
Date employment ended	19 October 2007
Gross weekly pay	€265.00

This award is made subject to the appellant having been in insurable employment under the Social Welfare Acts during the relevant period.

The appellant's employment ceased without notice and she is therefore entitled to six weeks' gross pay in the amount of €1590,00 under the Minimum Notice and Terms of Employment Acts, 1973 to 2001.
