Determination:

The Tribunal, being satisfied that a transfer of undertakings had not occurred in this case, finds that the appellant is entitled to a lump sum payment under the Redundancy Payments Acts, 1967 to 2003 based on the following criteria:

Date of Birth Employment commenced Employment ended Gross weekly pay 14 June 1975 17 September 2001 29 February 2008 €1024-38

It should be noted that payments from the social insurance fund are limited to a maximum of €600-00 per week. This award is made subject to the appellant having been in insurableemployment under the Social Welfare Acts during the relevant period.
