The decision of the Tribunal was as follows:-

The respondent conceded that the appellant was entitled to be paid statutory redundancy, however he was not in a position to pay him his entitlements under the Redundancy Acts. The appellant secured alternative employment immediately at a lower rate of salary.

Determination:

The Tribunal is satisfied that the appellant was dismissed by reason of redundancy and he is entitled to a redundancy lump sum under the Redundancy Payments Acts, 1967 to 2003 based on the following:

30th March 1985 Date of Birth Date employment commenced Date employment ended Gross weekly wage

15th February 2004 27th November 2007 €740.61

Please note that a weekly ceiling of €600 applies to all payments from the Social Insurance Fund

In accordance with the Department of Enterprise Trade and Employment Redundancy Calculator the lump sum due to the appellant is $\in 5,148.00$.

We also award the appellant €96 under the Minimum Notice and Terms of Employment Acts, 1973 to 2001 being the pay differential with his new job.
