The decision of the Tribunal was as follows:

The Tribunal is satisfied that the respondent was on notice of hearing. Based on the uncontested evidence of the appellant the Tribunal determines that he is entitled to a redundancy lump sum payment under the Redundancy Payments Acts, 1967 to 2003, based on the following information:

Date of Commencement:	2 <sup>nd</sup> September 2002
Date of Termination:	14 <sup>th</sup> September 2007
Gross Weekly Pay:	€924.36

This award is made subject to the appellant having been in insurable employment under the Social Welfare Acts during the relevant period.

The Tribunal allows the appeal under the Minimum Notice and Terms of Employment Acts, 1973 to 2001, and awards the appellant €3697.44 as compensation for four weeks notice.

The claim under the Organisation of Working Time Act, 1997 fails due to lack of evidence.

It should be noted that a statutory weekly ceiling of €600.00 applies to payments from the Social Insurance Fund.
