The decision of the Tribunal was as follows:

The Tribunal heard that the appellant was employed by a partnership formed by the first and second-named respondents. The Tribunal heard that redundancy was not in dispute between the parties.

Determination:

The Tribunal finds that the appellant is entitled to a redundancy lump sum under the Redundancy Payments Acts, 1967 to 2003, based on the following criteria:

Date of Birth: 12 October 1975

Date employment commenced: 21 January 2001
Date employment ended: 26 October 2007
Gross weekly salary €775.33

Please note that a statutory gross weekly ceiling limit of €600.00 currently applies to payments from the Social Insurance Fund.

This award is made subject to the appellant having been in insurable employment under the Social Welfare Acts during the relevant period.
